Requirements:

Associate Researcher: This is a full-time 3 year developmental position and the successful appointee will be required to register for a higher degree.

A first professional degree in an appropriate discipline is essential; postgraduate qualifications an advantage. Evidence of research activities and skills confirming potential as a Researcher. Interest in and commitment to teaching required; experience an advantage. Training for a professional registration would be an advantage.

Researcher: This is a full-time grant-funded position for 3 years but high performance may lead to future possibilities for the successful employee. A Master's degree essential. Registration for a Phd required; Phd an advantage. Evidence of competence as a Researcher essential, teaching experience an advantage. Professional registration an advantage.
